This training is geared for current scouts and adopters, as well as new volunteers who are interested in adopting a section of the PCT. The training will focus on the elements and requirements for volunteering with PCTA, how to handle the necessary paperwork, and, importantly, how to assess physical impacts along the trail, record that information and share it with PCTA and other trail maintainers.

June 4: [Northern Sierra Crew Leader Training](#)

This training is for volunteers with moderate to extensive trail building experience who want to lead trail crews and work parties on the PCT in the Northern Sierra. This training will follow the curriculum for [304 Crew Leadership: Managing Volunteers](#). This is not a construction techniques class; this training is about effective leadership. Students will learn about work day responsibilities, risk assessment and safety, tool safety and tool talks, leadership, and team building.
